

**NOTICE OF SUSPENSION MADE UNDER THE BUILDING AND  
CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY SECURITY OF PAYMENT ACT (NSW) 1999**

- In exercising our right to suspend **[work/supply of related goods and services]**, we are not liable for any loss or damage suffered by you during this period of suspension.
